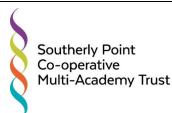

Please ensure that no sweets, chocolate, tins (pop) or glass bottles are included in packed lunches. Under Cornwall Council's fruit scheme all Reception, Year 1 and 2's are entitled to a free piece of fruit or vegetable every day which is provided in school (seasonal). We encourage all children to have a piece of fruit during morning break and would ask that children in Years 3 to 6 bring a piece of fruit each day.
